What happens when you put 33 hungry men in the same room? What happens when you put 33 hungry men in the same room, half a mile under ground for days and days with no access to food? In Chile, you get one man, Jose Samuel Henriquez, taking on the role of spiritual leader.

Hope eroded. Some questioned, "Why didn't God kill us right away?" Others wrote letters to loved ones to be read posthumously. After 16 days the empty food box mocked the hungry miners.

Jose remembered the story of Jesus multiplying the bread and fish. He gathered his coworkers and announced, "we are going to pray; tomorrow the box will be full of food. We will have food in abundance."

On day 17, the next day, the probe made contact with them. The multiplication was real; they saw how the box was filling up with food exceedingly. It was a miracle, a glorious moment. Campus Crusade for Christ-Chile later sent into the mine MP3 players containing a dramatized story telling of the Jesus Film to spiritually feed the men.

During the 69 day experience, twenty men, trapped in the mine, indicated decisions to commit their lives to Christ.

As I reflect on that environment, I realize how it is so easy to do good things, be good and live daily without a true dependency on God. We can balance a family budget, teach Sunday school, walk the dog in our power easily enough. Do I really need God's spirit to intervene in my life during a silly ten minute walk with our dog, Yukon?

Walking in the Spirit moment by moment is a lifestyle. It is learning to depend upon the Holy Spirit for His abundant resources as a way of life. Ephesians 5:18 commands us to be filled with the Spirit and I John 5:14-15 says if we ask anything according to His will he hears us and we will have what we've asked of Him. So we can be confident that God will help us to walk moment by moment in the power of the Holy Spirit.
